Dear Ballard Little League Parents and Guardians:

Ballard Little League (BLL) is a program of service to the youth in our community. BLL is a chartered member of Little League Baseball, Incorporated, bound by the Little League Operating Manual and Official Regulations and Playing Rules. There are some areas in which the local league has discretionary authority to adopt rules and procedures specific to their local league. As a league, we rely solely on parent and community volunteers to conduct league affairs, including board positions, managers, coaches and umpires. There are no paid positions.

Each year candidates for the manager and coaches positions are recommended to the BLL Board of Directors for appointment, after completing a coach's application and submitting to a criminal history check. Managers and coaches from the previous season are also evaluated for reappointment. Recommendations for reappointment are based in part on your input.

Your feedback is very important, as the league wants to provide a positive environment for the players, continue to do the right things and identify & address areas where there is opportunity for improvement.
