Selection Process
9 and 10 Year Old Softball All Star Team**

1. Eligible players will meet the following conditions:
 - Born 1/1/96 to 12/31/97
 - Played on a major or AAA division team for at least one half of the regular season games as of June 15
 - Meet the criteria established by Little League for residence within Ballard Little League boundaries (generally south of N. W. 85th to the canal and west of 8th Ave. N. W. to the Sound). Certain exceptions may apply.
 - Letter of Intent signed by parent/guardian and received by Ballard Little League's President (Kelly Jones, 7718 27th Ave NW, Seattle, 98117) by end of the day, **Tuesday, May 22, 2007**. Letters of Intent that are received after May 22, 2007, either in person or by mail, will NOT be accepted. **An original birth certificate or certified copy must be submitted with the Letter of Intent.**
2. To roster an All Star team, at least 12 players must submit a Letter of Intent. Should fewer than 12 players submit a Letter of Intent, Ballard will combine its players with a neighboring league in order to field an All Star team. An evaluation clinic will be scheduled only if more than 12 players submit Letters of Intent. These clinics would be held in late May & early June at a location to be determined.
3. Names of the players on the All Star team will be announced no sooner than **June 15**. All eligible players will be notified of the results by telephone.
4. Practices will begin during the week of June 15. Tournament games may begin as soon as the weekend of June 30.
